- You introduced yourself.
- 0012 You washed your hands. To maintain patient safety, it is important to wash your hands as soon as you enter the room.
- 0124 You identified the child. To maintain patient safety, it is important that you quickly identify the child.
- 0133 You identified the relatives. This is important, as the patient is below 18 years of age.
- 0159 You obtained legal consent from the child's relative. This was reasonable.
- 0307 You looked for normal breathing. She is breathing at 30 breaths per minute. The chest is moving equally.
- 0334 You attached the pulse oximeter. This was indicated by order.
- 0350 You attached the automatic noninvasive blood pressure (NIBP) measurement cuff. This will allow you to reassess the child continuously.
- 0407 You measured the temperature in the ear. The temperature was 99 F (37.2 C).
- 0425 You checked the pulse at the brachial artery. The pulse is strong, 185 per minute, and regular. It is correct to assess the child's vital signs.
- 0450 You assessed the child's IV. The site had no redness, swelling, infiltration,
