GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

61 y/o female, oriented X 3. Admitted diagnoses Acute Liver Failure and Jaundice.

Neurological/Sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Alert, oriented X 3. Pupils 3 mm equal, round reactive to light. Moves all extremities on command. HGTW equal & strong bilaterally. Speaks English clearly. Pain level 0 on 1-10 pain scale.

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

Flat affect but Responsive, interacts appropriately with spouse and staff

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Sclera clear & white without drainage. Ears symmetrical, auditory canals without drainage. Nasal septum midline, mucosa pink.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest symmetrical, trachea midline. Respirations 20 and unlabored. Breath sounds clear to auscultation bilaterally. Breathing room air.

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

Heart sounds audible with regular rate & rhythm. Apical pulse 72, radial pulses 2+, pedal pulses 0, no edema noted. Denies chest pain or discomfort. Nailbeds pink, capillary refill < 3 seconds.

Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation) Abdomen distended and firm. Active bowel sounds X 4 quadrants. Denies tenderness to palpation

Genitourinary-Reproductive (frequency, urgency, continence, color, clarity, odor, vaginal bleeding, discharge) _____ voids and denies odor or pain. Post-menopausal
