Diarrhea, injection site pain, vomiting, injection site phlebitis	1. monitor for signs of serum sickness 2. consult HCP if signs of severe diarrhea 3. monitor CBC if treatment course longer than 10 days 4. monitor for symptomatic improvement
Morphine Sulfate	Opioid	Moderate-severe pain	0.75 mg IV PRN q4hr		Reconstitute 5mL with normal saline and administer over 5 min	Pruritus, constipation, nausea, vomiting, dizziness, somnolence	1. BBW: life threatening respiratory depression may occur 2. monitor for severe constipation 3. continually reassess pain 4. monitor for S/S of respiratory depression
Acetaminophen/Codeine phosphate	Opioid mixed with acetaminophen	Mild-moderate pain	1.6 mL PO PRN q4hr			Sweating, nausea, vomiting, lightheadedness	1. BBW: dosing errors can occur due to confusion between mg and mL may lead to accidental overdose 2. monitor for serotonin syndrome 3. monitor for s/s of respiratory depression 4. contraindicated less than 12 yo call HCP

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Acetaminophen	Opioid analgesic	antipyretic	100 mg PO PRN q4hr			Pruritus, constipation, insomnia, agitation, atelectasis	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> unsafe to take more than 4000mg in 24 hours advise parent or caregiver to closely read label monitor pain relief BBW: dosing errors may result in accidental overdose and death
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
