Furosemide	loop diuretic	treats fluid retention, edema	10 mg IV BID			Hyperuricemia, hypomagnesemia, loss of appetite, spastic bladder	1. BBW: potent diuretic if given in excessive amounts, can lead to profound diuresis 2. may cause sun sensitivity 3. monitor for hypertension 4. advise parents to use sunscreen on child when going outside
Digoxin	Digitalis glycosides	antiarrhythmics	37 mcg PO BID			Fatigue, weakness, arrhythmias, bradycardia, blurred vision	1. monitor apical pulse 1 min before administering 2. strict I&O's 3. daily weights 4. monitor electrolytes
Acetaminophen	Nonopioid analgesics	antipyretics	80 mg PO PRN q4hr			Pruritus, constipation, insomnia, agitation, atelectasis	1. BBW: dosing errors may result in accidental overdose and death 2. monitor pain relief 3. read label closely 4. unsafe taking more than 4000 mg/24hr

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
