

IM5 Online Non-Graded CPE Requirement and Instructions

In order to receive credit for participation in the IM5 Online Non-Graded CPE you must complete the online “Post-Op Pediatric Clinical Simulation” experience.

The Post-Op Pediatric Clinical Simulation Game simulates a clinical experience that promotes the application of knowledge and skills for critical thinking and clinical decision making related to caring for a 10-year-old boy who has just had an appendectomy and his mother.

The learning objectives of this simulation game are to:

- Complete an evidenced-based post-operative assessment of a pediatric patient.
- Apply pain-management care principles to a pediatric post-operative patient.
- Demonstrate therapeutic communication to facilitate family-centered care.
- Demonstrate correct drug calculations related to administering IV medications to a pediatric patient.
