PART #1 – Pre-brief: “End-of-Life Care for Patients with Cystic Fibrosis”

As you read, consider the following and be prepared to discuss the following during the group debrief:

1. What is active care?
2. How does active care in a pediatric patient with cystic fibrosis differ than in a child with cancer?
3. What components does end-of-life planning include?
4. Compare and contrast a durable power of attorney for health care as discussed in this article with the term consent by proxy as discussed in the “Pediatric Assessment & Interventions” lecture (Unit 1 content). What is similar? What is different?
5. Review each of the “priorities at end of life” in the article.

After watching the video,

- Write a reflection (11-point Arial or Calibri font, double-spaced, minimum of 2 pages) that includes responses to the following questions. Be prepared to discuss your responses to these questions during the group debrief.

1. How did you feel throughout the time that you were watching the video?
 2. Give a description of Claire’s condition and identify the main problems that you identified?
 3. Based on your observations, what were her clinical manifestations and how would you explain these clinical manifestations?
 4. What specific nursing interventions would you want to take into consideration to provide for this patient’s unique care needs?
 5. What other members of the care team should you consider important to achieving good care outcomes?
 6. What financial challenges did this family face because of Claire’s condition?
 7. What did you learn from this experience?
 8. How will you apply what you learned by watching this video to your clinical practice?
 9. What are your feelings about caring for a child that is actively dying?
 10. Is there anything else you would like to include in your reflection of this experience?
