- ❖ Why is Sidelying position better for feeding preterm infants? Regulated control of how you externally pace baby so they can regulate ballast control and safe when feeding. Opportunity to use backhand to feel breathing and respirations and swallow and provide trunk elongated position so they are not flexed and put pressure on the abdomen which causes reflex.
- ❖ What are some indications for feeding tube placement discussed in the video? Infant is unable to take milk by oral route due to prematurity, feeding immaturity, neurological disease, poor oro-motor skills, infants who have respiratory distress, tachypnea or those who receive assisted ventilation.
- ❖ How long before the cord stump falls off? 1-3 weeks
- ❖ What are some tips for changing a male newborn diaper? Place wipe over his penis to avoid getting sprayed.
