

- ❖ Why is Sidelying position better for feeding preterm infants?

The bottle is horizontal to the ground and in the baby's mouth allowing the feeder to have more control over the flow of milk. This position can make breathing easier and more comfortable because it provides a very nice, elongated position for the preterm infant. This position is safer for the preterm infant.

- ❖ What are some indications for feeding tube placement discussed in the video?

Prematurity, feeding immaturity, poor oro-motor skills, and infants receiving assisted ventilation

- ❖ How long before the cord stump falls off?

1-3weeks

- ❖ What are some tips for changing a male newborn diaper?

Place a wipe over his penis to avoid getting sprayed

If the baby still has an umbilical cord stump, fold the top part of the diaper over so that it won't irritate the stump

To help prevent blowouts and leaks, make sure the ruffles around the legs and the panel in the back aren't tucked in
