

## Discussion Questions

1. Sidelying position is better for feeding because you can pace the baby while they are eating which makes feeding safer, and while they are eating you can put your hand on their back to assess swallowing and respirations. This position can also prevent the baby to put pressure on the abdomen which would cause reflux.
2. Some indications for feeding tube placement are premature babies because they cannot take milk in through the oral route due to not developing that sucking until 34 weeks of age, infants with feeding immaturity, poor oral motor skills, and infants who require ventilation.
3. The cord stump falls off at 2 weeks after birth.
4. Some tips for changing a male newborn diaper are to put a wipe over the penis to avoid urine contact during diaper change.
