Thiamine	Vitamin B	Alcohol withdrawal	100 mg po daily			Hypersensitivity reaction	1. Take with food 2. watch out for toxicity 3. if given IV watch out for injection site reaction 4. make sure to drink lots of water
Folic Acid	Vitamin B	Alcohol withdrawal	1 mg po daily			Bad taste in mouth, loss of appetite, nausea, confusion, irritability	1. watch out for nausea 2. Take as prescribed 3. don't stop taking even after you start to feel better 4. eat a healthy diet
Acamprosate	Ethanol dependency	Help maintain sobriety	666 mg po TID			Pruritus, diarrhea, flatulence, nausea, depression, anxiety	1. Might make drowsy so avoid activities requiring mental alertness 2. will not eliminate alcohol withdrawal but with help with symptoms 3. if you start drinking again call your doctor 4. could enhance suicidal ideation

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Ibuprofen	NSAID	analgesia	200 mg po prn pain > 2 on 1-10 pain scale	<input type="text"/> Yes	n/a	Hypotension, rash, hypoalbuminemia, hypoproteinemia, heartburn, thrombocytosis	1. Watch liver enzymes that are already elevated 2. watch H&H labs because it can cause thrombocytosis 3. don't use any other NSAIDs or aspirin while taking 4. do not drink while on this medication
ondansetron	5-HT3-serotonin receptor agonist	Antiemetic	8 mg po or IV prn nausea	<input type="text"/>	diluent needed, give over 2-5 mins	Constipation, diarrhea, headache, hypoxia, fatigue	1. Keep eye on vitals and respiration status 2. notify if you are constipated 3. don't chew the tablet if given orally 4. run an EKG if on the med for awhile for QT prolongation
lorazepam	Benzodiazepine	Antianxiety	2- 4 mg IV or po prn CIWA-ar protocol	<input type="text"/>	1-2mL diluted in 1-2mL of NS or D5W, give over a max of 2mg/min so 1-2 mins	Asthenia, dizziness, sedation, unsteadiness, depression, delirium	1. Avoid activity that requires mental alertness 2. keep eye on respirations because it can cause respiratory depression 3. don't stop the drug suddenly 4. avoid alcohol or other CNS depressants
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
