1. What are the three hallmark signs of opioid toxicity?
 - Respiratory depression, pinpoint pupils, coma
2. What are the pharmacological agents used for opioid toxicity reversal?
 - Narcan, nalmeferene
3. Name three nursing interventions for the treatment of a patient experiencing an opioid overdose other than medication:
 - Create a low stimulating environment
 - Hydration- give PO fluids and encourage eating
 - Be supportive and be there for them to talk too
4. Name the symptoms of opioid withdrawal:
 - Yawning, insomnia, irritability, rhinorrhea, panic, diaphoresis, cramps, N/V, muscle aches, bone pain, chills, fever, diarrhea, increased BP and HR
5. What is the treatment for opioid withdrawal?
 - Hydration, give them a low stimulation environment, monitoring their vitals, a reversal agent on hand, oxygen if needed
6. What are treatments to sustain and promote abstinence from opioid use?
 - Methadone clinics, detox, buprenorphine, or naltrexone,
