Situation: Hello this is Jenna Dixon RN; I'm calling about Evet Ogam a 34-year-old female. She came in with heroin overdose.

Background: She came in two times before with heroin abuse prior. She is allergic to aspirin. She has a history of a back surgery in 2012. Her labs are pending for CBC, CMP, ETOH, urine toxicology, magnesium and phosphorus. She has a history of depression and drug abuse

Assessment: Her vital signs are BP: 150/85, Pulse: 122, RR: 22, T: 98.6, O2:100% and rated pain as a 25. Her COWs score was a 30. She is agitated, was nauseous states throwing up 3 times since admission. She has diarrhea. Very restless and could not sleep very well last night. She is diaphoretic and has tremors.

Recommendation: I recommend, we order medications for her pain, nausea, diarrhea, agitation and withdrawal. She is able to take another dose of Ibuprofen, however I do not think that it is adequately treating her pain. Thank you
