PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT NARRATIVE BY SYSTEMS: (Complete using assessment check list and reminders below).

GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

03/02/21 at 0749 VIS completed, Pt was awake and alert, Pt was admitted primarily for UTI. Pt was calm and friendly.

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Alert, oriented x3. Pupils 2mm and equal, round and reactive to light. Moves all extremities on command, responds to sharp/soft sensations. Hand grasp toe wiggle equal/strong bilaterally. Movements purposeful/ coordinated. Speaks English/Spanish clearly. Overall upper and lower extremities were strong in force.

Comfort level: Pain rates at 8 **(0-10 scale) Location:** N/A.

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

No family at bedside, calm and friendly with staff.

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

Sclera clear/white w/out drainage. Ears symmetrical, auditory canals w/out drainage. Hears spoken voice w/out difficulty. Nasal septum midline, mucosa pink, moist and intact. Neck supple w/ palpable lymph nodes. Trachea midline, swallows with ease. No aspiration.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest symmetrical, no bruises, wounds or scars. Trachea midline. Respirations 18 even/unlabored. Breath sounds clear to auscultation bilaterally. Breathing room air. O2 sat on (RA) 95%.

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

S1 and S2 audible w/ regular rate and rhythm. Apical rate of 67. Pedal pulses 1+ bilaterally, no edema noted. BP 118/69. Radial pulses 2+ bilaterally. Denies chest pain. Nail beds pink, capillary refill < 3 secs. Overall regular rise patterns.
