EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Sclera clear & white without drainage. Ears symmetrical, auditory canals without drainage. Hears spoken voice without difficulty. Nasal septum midline, mucosa pink, oral mucosa membranes pink, moist & intact. Swallows without difficulty.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern) Chest symmetrical, trachea midline. Respirations 16, even and unlabored. Breath sounds clear to auscultation, bilaterally. Breathing room air. O2 sat at 93%

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern) Apical rate 68, radial pulses 2+ bilaterally with a rate of 68. Pedal pulses 2+ bilaterally, no edema noted. BP 123/73. Nailbeds pink capillary refill < 2-3 seconds

Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation) Abdomen distended, soft & non-tender. Active bowel sounds X4 quadrants. Patient stated last BM was 2/27/21 light brown and soft (not observed) Last BM 2/27/21

Genitourinary-Reproductive (frequency, urgency, continence, color, clarity, odor, vaginal bleeding, discharge) Voids clear, yellow urine. Denies odor or pain.
