- You introduced yourself.
- ✓ 0019 You [washed your hands](#). To maintain patient safety, it is important to wash your hands as soon as you enter the room.
- ✓ 0114 You [identified the child](#). To maintain patient safety, it is important that you quickly identify the child.
- ✓ 0123 You [identified the relatives](#). This is important, as the patient is below 18 years of age.
- ✓ 0150 You obtained [legal consent](#) from the child's relative. This was reasonable.
- ✓ 0341 You sat the child up. It is correct to do so.
- ✓ 0353 You gave the child 100% oxygen from a [nonrebreathing mask](#). This was part of your orders.
- ✓ 0422 You [looked for normal breathing](#). He is breathing at 30 breaths per minute. He has retractions, a prolonged expiration phase, and a lot of audible wheezing. There is increased respiratory effort.
- ✓ 0452 You [checked the pulse](#) at the brachial artery. The pulse is strong, 145 per minute, and regular. It is correct to assess the child's vital signs.
- ✓ 0518 You attached the automatic [noninvasive blood pressure](#) (NIBP) measurement cuff. This will allow you to reassess the child continuously.

- ✗ You should have asked the relative about any known [health problems](#).
- ✗ Consider providing [patient education](#) whenever possible.
- ✗ Consider [providing education](#) to relatives whenever possible.
