PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT NARRATIVE BY SYSTEMS: (Complete using assessment check list and reminders below).

GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

Patient admitted for UTI and sepsis secondary. Assessed at 0734 upon waking. Appears comfortable and sitting up in bed

Neurological–sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Patient oriented x3. Pupils PERRL. HGTW with no complications. Patient able to move all extremities well. Speech clear.

Comfort level: Pain rates at 5 **(0-10 scale) Location:** Lower abdomen

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

Friendly and interactive with staff. No family present at bedside.

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Sclera clear and white with no discharge noted. Ears symmetrical canals without

discharge. Nasal septum midline, oral mucous membranes pink moist and intact.

No palpable lymph nodes present

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Respirations 24 even and unlabored. Chest symmetrical. Breath sounds CTA bilaterally.

O2 97% on room air

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

Normal rate and rhythm on auscultation. Pulse rate 72, radial pulses 2+ bilaterally.

Pedal pulses 2+ bilaterally no edema on exam. B/P 111/76 capillary refill <3 seconds. Denies chest pain or discomfort.

Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation) Abdomen flat and soft with mild tenderness on palpation. Active bowel sounds x4 quadrants. Patient states last BM was 3/21/2021 normal color and consistency.
