PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT NARRATIVE BY SYSTEMS: (Complete using assessment check list and reminders below).

GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)
0900. Patient admitted with right pleural effusion. Appears alert and responsive.

Neurological–sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)
Alert, oriented x3. Appropriately reacts to dull and sharp sensations. Pupils 3 mm equal, round, and reactive to light. Able to move all extremities on command. Hand grasps and toe wiggle equal and strong bilaterally. Movements purposful and coordinated.

Comfort level: Pain rates at 8 **(0-10 scale) Location:** Right lower abdomen

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)
Friendly affect, interacts appropriately with staff and family.

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) Sclera clear and white. No visible drainage. Ears symmetrical and without drainage. Slight difficulty hearing. Nasal septum midline, mucosa pink. Oral mucous membrane pink, moist, and intact. No visible or palpable lymph nodes.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)
Chest symmetrical, trachea midline. Resprations 20, even and slightly labored. Breath sounds diminished, most notable on right side. Room air O2 91%. Placed on 2 L oxygen.

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)
S1 and S2 audible with regular rate and rhythm. Apical rate 70, radial pulses 2+ bilaterally, no notable edema. B/P 130/78. No chest pain or discomfort reported. Nailbeds pink, capillary refill <2-3 seconds. Radial rate 70.
