1. What are the three hallmark signs of opioid toxicity?
  - Pinpoint pupils
  - Difficulty breathing
  - Unconscious
2. What are the pharmacological agents used for opioid toxicity reversal?
  - Naloxone, Nalmefene
3. Name three nursing interventions for the treatment of a patient experiencing an opioid overdose other than medication:
  - Airway management via mechanical ventilation
  - Lay patient on side and start an IV
  - Resuscitation if necessary
4. Name the symptoms of opioid withdrawal:
  - Lacrimation, Mydriasis, panic, agitation, cravings, yawning, muscle aches, GI upset, chills, diaphoresis, piloerection, rhinorrhea.
5. What is the treatment for opioid withdrawal?
  - Pain medication, IV fluids, prophylactic antibiotics, and comfort measures as well as thermal regulation.
  - Medications given can be: Buprenorphine, Methadone, Clonidine
6. What are treatments to sustain and promote abstinence from opioid use?
  - The treatments to sustain and promote abstinence from opioid use is Vivitrol, CBT, support and detox groups.
