risperidone	Atypical antipsychotic	Treat mania symptoms of bipolar disorder	2 mg po qd			Agitation, anxiety, changes in vision, muscle spasms, polyuria	1. Black box: use caution with elderly patients 2. Instruct patient to get up slowly 3. Teach patient to report s/s of tardive dyskinesia and EPS 4. Patient should not drink alcohol with
