

CPE Consent Script:

1. **Nature of mental/physical condition:** Schizophrenia
2. **Expected benefits:** We hope that with the Invega you will... have a decrease in hallucinations, decrease in the voices you hear, and you will regain the desire of your daily life activities such as increased desire to go back to school and take care of your hygiene.
3. **Probable health consequences of not taking this med:** With not agreeing to take this medication you may be hospitalized for longer; you may have increased/worsened mania/symptoms.
4. **Alternatives of treatment:** There are other antipsychotics, but this medication was picked by the physician because you've already have been taking the oral dose of this medication (Paliperidol) and you have not had any adverse effects, this medication is the long acting which will give you more consistent medication management and you won't have to take this as often.
5. **Description of the proposed course of treatment:** The first dose will be 234 mg injection. On day 8 the dose will be 156 mg. Then a month later will be your monthly dose (78mg-234 mg) and then your maintenance dose will be every month after that.
6. **Side effects with any med:** "There are risks/side effects for any medication."
7. **Side effects of this drug:** "This particular drug's side effects are....
 - a. **Frequent s/e:** Injection site reactions, sedation, dizziness, akathisia (muscle quivering/restlessness), or extrapyramidal disorder (muscle slowness, jerky movements), and may cause some changes in the rhythm of your heart.
 - b. **Predisposed s/e:** "We don't anticipate you wouldn't have any new side effects because it is the same classification as the daily oral dose you've been taking".
 - c. **Nature and possible irreversible s/e:** Second generation antipsychotics may present target dyskinesia after long term use... which is irreversible and involuntary muscle movements such as eye blinking, tongue thrusting, and facial grimacing. If you start having these symptoms, please notify your health care team."
 - d. **S/e with pregnancy:** "Pregnancy is contraindicated w/ this med. If you become pregnant or desire to become pregnant with med, please contact your provider. Breast feeding is also contraindicated as this medication can be passed through breast milk to the infant."
8. **What s/e need to be reported:** "If any of the side effects that I mentioned prior, especially tardive dyskinesia or pregnancy occurs, please notify your health care team and provider".
9. **Instruction about the patient has the right to withdraw consent at any time**
10. All questions answered concerning this medication.

hand clipboard to the patient to sign consent

Shake med before putting needle on, use 1 inch needle (because patient is less than 90 kg), use z-track method, aspirate needle
