BWV: QT interval prolongation and serious arrhythmias can occur</li> <li>2. Monitor respiratory rate (can cause life threatening respiratory depression)</li> <li>3. Monitor patient for hypotensive episodes</li> <li>4. High doses contraindicated with renal impairment</li> </ol>
Mineral oil + Petroleum Opth Oint	Lubricant	Keep eyes moist	1 gm Both eyes Q4H	N/A. 3.5 g tube	N/A	Irritation of the eyes or surrounding skin	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Ensure that the tube tip does not come in contact with the patient's eye</li> <li>2. Gently massage the ointment area</li> <li>3. Discontinue if any redness or irritation is noted</li> <li>4. Ensure waiting at 5 least minutes for further ophthalmologic medication administration</li> </ol>

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Docusate Sodium	Laxative Stool softener	Prevent constipation as an SE of opioid use	10 mg PO (TPT tube) BID	Yes Do not exceed 100 mg/day.	Concentration: 100mg/10ml	diarrhea, dehydration, nausea, musculoskeletal cramps, hepatotoxicity	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Monitor LFTs</li> <li>2. Monitor electrolytes (risk dehydration/diarrhea )</li> <li>3. Monitor stool for blood/rectal bleeding</li> <li>4. Avoid prolonged treatment</li> </ol>
Famotidine Suspension	Gastric acid secretion inhibitor	Inhibits concentration and volume of gastric secretion	0.25 ml PO (TPT tube) BID	Yes. 1mg/kg/day divided twice daily	Concentration: 8mg/ml	Constipation, diarrhea, headache, stevens-johnson syndrome, necrotizing enterocolitis in new born, seizure	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Monitor stool consistency and frequency</li> <li>2. Asses bowel sounds before and after administration</li> <li>3. May need to combine with antacid if experiencing more s/s GERD</li> <li>4. Frequent GI assessment (avoid NEC complications)</li> </ol>
