

OB Group Presentation Instructions

Instructional Module 6

Group Size

Each group will consist of **two** students unless there are an uneven number of students, in which case there will be one group of three students.

Topic

Each group will choose a topic from the list provided and prepare a presentation reflecting the research on the chosen topic. Once the topic is chosen a literature search should be performed to gather information for the presentation. Two scholarly journal article resources are **required**. See the LMS instructions on what constitutes a scholarly JOURNAL article.

Presentation

The group will create a 5-10 minute professional power point presentation covering the outlined objectives. Each group member will be required to present a portion of the presentation to their peers and instructors. Please check the calendar for the date and classroom assignment of the presentations. **Professional dress is required for the presentation.**

Group Presentation Objectives

1. Describe the topic background or disease pathology.
2. Discuss patient impact related to the topic.
3. Describe the role of the nurse related to your topic:
 - a. Include nursing actions/responsibilities
 - b. What patient education needs to be included
 - c. Address community resources that are available to the patient and/or discuss the impact the topic may have to the community
4. Research findings are presented professionally in an easy to read PowerPoint presentation (font size should not be less than 20), and free of spelling and grammatical errors.
5. References **must** be in APA format (see LMS lesson on APA) and include a **minimum** of 2 scholarly, evidenced based articles and references. Use APA 7th edition.
 - a. A copy of the references (in APA format) will be submitted to the instructors **before** the presentation.
 - b. Other resources, such as websites and textbooks may be used **in addition** to the scholarly articles if more information is needed and must be properly cited in APA format.
6. Demonstrate group teamwork during the presentation.
7. Team members demonstrate a professional appearance and rapport during presentation.
