SBAR-1 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Sterile Gloving, CVAD Dressing Change, Parenteral Medication Administration (IM, SQ) and Focused Assessment

- CVAD Kit
- Extra Transparent Dressing
- Sterile Gloves
- Syringes (3 mL and Insulin)
- Alcohol Pads
- 10 mL Vial
- Blue Labels
- Blue Caps
- Simulated Injection Object (ie: orange, etc.)

SBAR-2 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Medication Administration (IV) and Focused Assessment

- 50- or 100-mL Bag
- 500 mL Bag
- IV Tubings (2)
- 3 mL syringes
- Saline Flushes
- Alcohol Swabs
- Labels (blue, orange, green, pink)
- Blue Caps
- Orange Swab Caps

SBAR-3 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Oxygenation, Medication Administration (Enteral), Focused Assessment

Enteral

- Simulated Sterile Water Container
- Oral Medication syringe
- Small Towel
- Irrigation Tray

CVAD Blood Draw

- 10 mL syringe
- Flush Syringes
- Max-Zero Needless Connector
- Alcohol Swabs

SBAR- 4 Concepts: Asepsis, Patient Safety

Skills practice to reinforce concepts: Indwelling Catheter Insertion, Intermittent catheter insertion, Medication Administration and Focused Assessment

- Both Catheter Kits
- Sterile Gloves
- 3 mL & 10 mL syringes
- Saline Flushes
- Alcohol Swabs
- Labels (blue, pink)
- Blue Caps
- Orange Swab Caps

Important Note: Once kit is opened, take a picture for exact repacking. Do NOT open betadine or lubricant packages – will simulate only.
