- 1) List in order of priority your initial nursing actions identified for Eva Madison based on physical findings and family interaction.
 - wash hands
 - identify patient and family
 - ask about pain and illness
 - take vitals
 - asses respiratory and cardiovascular and skin
 - admin maintenance fluid
 - take urine and stool sample
 - check to see how they feel
 - reassess
 - teach parent and patient
 - hand wash and leave

- 2) What complications might Eva Madison face if her symptoms are not recognized and treated in a timely manner?
 - respiratory depression
 - decreased blood pressure
 - severe dehydration
 - shock
 - seizures
