- ✔ 0043 You [identified the child](#). To maintain patient safety, it is important that you quickly identify the child.
- ✔ 0053 You [identified the relatives](#). This is important, as the patient is below 18 years of age.
- ✔ 0111 You verified signed consent from the child's relative. This was reasonable.
- ✔ 0244 You provided [patient education](#). This is correct. It is important to use every opportunity to provide [patient education](#).
- ✔ 0253 You provided [patient education](#).
- ✔ 0324 You attached the [pulse oximeter](#). This was indicated by order.
- ✔ 0328 You [looked for normal breathing](#). She is breathing at 28 breaths per minute. She has retractions, a prolonged expiration phase, and a lot of audible wheezing. There is increased respiratory effort.
- ✔ 0359 You attached the automatic [noninvasive blood pressure \(NIBP\)](#) measurement cuff. This will allow you to reassess the child continuously.
