Universal Competency	Critical Elements
Safety (physical and emotional)	Action by nurse- didn't perform hand hygiene when entering the room, didn't ask first and last name/date of birth. Didn't ask patients pain levels and or allergies before starting the procedure. Left the room and left the patient unattended. Leaned over and onto the patient when writing date and initials. Didn't put bed all the way down and ensure it was locked. Placed call light across patients neck putting them at risk for
Critical Thinking	Didn't palpate/assess site before removing dressing
Standard Precaution	Didn't let table dry after cleaning with solution before placing kit on it, didn't wash hands before sterile gloving, didn't apply dressing properly. Dropped hands below table when steril gloving. Didn't cleaning the insertion site for 30 seconds, instead, cleaning all around it for 15 seconds. Fanned insertion site dry instead of letting it dry on it's own. Didn't clean hub before attaching IV
Communication	Told patient the kit was new and that she was still learning how to use it--didn't communicate professionally. Said, "I think that's how that goes."--not speaking professionally or being trustworthy
Documentation	Didn't document dressing change, didn't save documentation
Human Caring and Relationship	Didn't take patients chest pain seriously and brushed it off
Professional Role Performance	Told patient how tired she was--wasn't acting professionally. Didn't appear professional when placing mask and choosing to wear it the wrong way
