Universal Competency	Critical Elements
Safety (physical and emotional)	Action by nurse-Didn't clean med tray before placing paper towel and meds in it. 7 rights to med admin-didn't verify dose with the eMAR. Didn't double check patient's blood sugar before pulling insulin and ended up pulling too much and administering too much. Didn't clean hands or put on gloves before pulling meds. Gave insulin injection in the incorrect location-gave in the deltoid muscle instead of the back of the arm. Didn't
Critical Thinking	Action by nurse-Didn't perform necessary assessments before continuing with what she was doing. Didn't assess the perineal aread before performing catheterization.
Standard Precaution	Action by nurse-Didn't call for a second nurse to verify insulin until after administering it and allowed the nurse to witness it anyway after the fact. Didn't check integrity of kit before using. Didn't check expiration date of kit before oping. Didn't clean the perineal aread before inserting catheter. Dind't measure urine output. Contaminated when steril gloving.
Communication	Didn't communicate and check on patient throughout procedure.
Documentation	Didn't document location insulin was administered in. Didn't get a second nurse witness until after administering insulin. Didn't document and save catheterization procedure.
Human Caring and Relationship	Action by nurse-didn't give patient an option on where they would like to have their insulin injection. Threw patient's legs open instead of asking them to spread them. Didn't provide patient with necessary privacy and allowed another nurse to walk in and have a conversation with her.
Professional Role Performance	Allowed another nurse in the room to have a very unprofessional conversation in front of patient.
