On November 16, 2010, Lisa Bates was working as an RN in a minimally invasive surgery center; was responsible for creating two fraudulent prescriptions with forged name of the physician for 1: adipex 35.7mg one (1) PO every AM, 30 tablets and Lortab 7.5 mg tablet one (1) PO every 4 hours PRN pain, 30 tablets

For this violation and to prevent this behavior of Lisa I would, as the surgical clinic, take inventory after every shift. I would also have random drug test for all nurses on each shift. I would do this to make sure the nurses at the clinic understand that this behavior is taken very seriously and will be monitored closely. To help temptation I would also have more education for the nurses and classes to help them really comprehend that this is not morally correct.
