4. One nursing intervention I would take would be encouraging her to wear her oxygen to maintain adequate oxygenation as well as promote measures to remove pulmonary secretions . I would also emphasize the need to maintain adequate nutrition . As well as prevent complications as I am able to .
5. The care team may consist of a pulmonologist, a respiratory therapist as well as a dietician.
6. Claire needed a lung transplant that costs lots of money .
7. I learned to cherish life because just when I think I have it hard, there is someone in the world dealing with an everyday struggle just to live a normal life.
