- Give a description of Claire's condition and identify the main problems that you identified? Cystic Fibrosis is an inherited disorder that causes severe damage to the lungs, some of the problems i noticed with Claire was she was on Oxygen continuously she had excessive mucus and always had a productive cough
- Based on your observations, what were her clinical manifestations and how would you explain these clinical manifestations?The Thick and sticky mucus associated with cystic fibrosis clogs the tubes that carry air in and out of the lungs. It has a persistent cough that produces thick mucus, wheezing use of oxygen, exercise intolerance , repeated lung infections
- What specific nursing interventions would you want to take into consideration to provide for this patient's unique care needs? The nurse would want to monitor respiratory and heart rate for any changes, asses for changes in respiratory status such as cyanosis pallor changes in the loc breathing and tachypnea, place the patient in semi fowlers position administer O2

- What other members of the care team should you consider important to achieving good care outcomes? The Respiratory Therapist

Clarie's parents weren't always able to be at the hospital with her when she was sick they had to send friends and family to check on her because they worked they started a Go Fund me so that they could raise money for her transplant
