Comments:

I did not voice to use the call light for any needs. I did not check the insulin against the eMAR in the med room. I failed to voice that I checked for air in the syringe. I failed to perform hand hygiene upon walking in the room and a few other times throughout the procedure. I did not palpate the area before administering the insulin shot, I needed to check for lipodystrophy and tenderness at the area. I did not use gloves when I cleaned the area of the skin before injection. I listened to 11 spots on the posterior lungs instead of 10. I realize I should have taken off my stethoscope before performing the CVAD dressing change. At the beginning of the dressing change I said I verified for “medications” when I should have said “cleaning agents.” I should have taught the patient about the CVAD dressing

and how to care for it. I failed patient safety by not taking off the patients mask and not checking for clutter in the room.

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
