GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

0900 Patient admitted with Right knee hematoma with drainage. On 12/29 patient had a I&D with polyexchange. Patient well-groomed and laying in bed _____

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

Alert and oriented x 4. Sensation intact HGTW strong Bilaterally. Coordinated and moves extremities excluding right leg due to leg in an immobilizer from surgery.

Speaks English clearly. Pupils 3mm round, equal and reactive to light. Patient responds to questions readily and friendly.

Comfort level: Pain rates at 4 (0-10 scale) Location: Right Knee

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

Patient shows outward expressions, answers friendly. Patient interacts appropriately with staff. Patient hears spoken voice without difficulty. Swallowing without difficulty _____

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing) **_EENT and Mouth symmetrical, no drainage. Redness to right eye. Dentition good. No palpable lymph nodes. Regular diet.**

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

_Chest symmetrical. Even deep unlabored breathing. Lungs clear to auscultation in all lung fields. Respiration rate 18. Diaphragm moving gently with no signs of distress. Breathing room air. _____

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern) **S1, S2 audible with even rhythm and Pattern. Capillary refill 2-3 seconds. Radial pulse 2+ Bilaterally, Pedal pulse 2+ Bilaterally with a rate of 57. BP 134/68**

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Gastrointestinal (bowel habits, appearance of abdomen, bowel sounds, tenderness to palpation)

Abdomen soft and nontender. Active bowel sounds x4 quadrants. States had a bowel movement on 1/03/22 formed brown stool.

Last BM 01/03/2022

Genitourinary-Reproductive (frequency, urgency, continence, color, clarity, odor, vaginal bleeding, discharge) **_Voids clear yellow urine. Denies any penile discharge but does have a rash and some redness to groin area. Vaginal Bleeding N/A. Denies any frequency, odor or pain with urination.**

Musculoskeletal (alignment, posture, mobility, gait, movement in extremities, deformities)

Unsteady gait due to surgery of right knee and has an immobilizer on. Patient is non-weight bearing to right leg. Patient needs partial assistance getting up and out of bed. Alignment symmetrical, posture upright. Movement in extremities is meaningful and voluntary.

Skin (skin color, temp, texture, turgor, integrity)


__ Skin warm and dry. Color appropriate to race but has red blotches/rash on abdomen, palms of hands, legs and both feet with blistering to some. Turgor normal.

Wounds/Dressings

_Hemovac drain with ace bandage and immobilizer to right knee. Foam dressing with zinc ointment to gluteal area for peeling skin rash.

Other

_IV site peripheral Right wrist 22G and Rt AC 22G dressing dry and intact.



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
