

<p>Patient #1 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint</p> <p>Tonsillitis / Difficulty swallowing</p>	<p>Patient #1 Teaching</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take and finish all antibiotics 2. Gargle with warm salt water for relieving discomfort 3. Stay well hydrated <p>Discharge planning/Community Resources</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Contact HCP if pain gets worse and does not get better after 2 days 2. Call 911 if you have trouble breathing due to swollen tonsils 3. Rest & return to daily activities as directed
<p>Patient #2 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint</p> <p>Acute Viral Syndrome / Fever, body ache, and headache</p>	<p>Patient #2 Teaching</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take Tylenol for fever/pain every 3 hours 2. Do not send to school if fever is 101 or up 3. Stay Hydrated (Water, Gatorade, Pedialyte) <p>Discharge Planning/Community Resources</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Follow up with HCP if not better in 2 days 2. Keep child away from other people while they are sick 3. Get medical attention if having trouble breathing
<p>Patient #3 Diagnosis/Chief Complaint</p> <p>Viral Syndrome / Hard to breathe, chest burns, "tingling" over body</p>	<p>Patient #3 Teaching</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alternate Tylenol/Motrin for pain/fever 2. Increase Fluids 3. Wash hands <p>Discharge Planning/Community Resources</p>
