GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

Assessed at 1100. Admitted with acute renal failure. Patient appears to be anxious, but in good spirits.

Alert & oriented x3. PERRL. Moves all extremities on command. HGTW equal & strong x2 sides. Speaks clearly. -

Ears w/out drainage. Oral mucous membranes pink, moist & intact. No palpable lymph nodes.

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

Chest symmetrical. Respirations 20 even & unlabored. Crackles in lower lobes inhaling & exhaling. O₂ @ 97% on RA.

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

NSR. Radial rate 76, & 2+ bilaterally. Pedal pulse 2+ bilaterally. Cap refill < 3 secs.
