

IM 2 Simulated Patient Clinical Video Grading Rubric

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There are three (3) ways to receive credit for the video:

1. Perform the scenario with all critical elements in each area of the grading tool
2. Verbalize a breach or mistake in real time and provide the nursing intervention to correct the breach or mistake then proceed with the video
3. When reviewing the video, honestly evaluate the nurse. Recognize all (if any) breaches or mistakes, record them as "unmet" and provide a nursing intervention to correct the breach or mistake

Comments:

1. After cleaning the med tray I would have cleaned my hands with hand sanitizer and put gloves on to pull the medication and to spike/ prime the tubing for medication.
2. While prepping the tube line, I would have done it over the sink to prevent a mess.
3. Before leaving the med room I would have labeled my medication bag before leaving the med room and right after I have confirmed my medication bag to the EMR.
4. I would have checked the compatibility to the saline bag that the patient already had hanging to make sure

that it is safe for the patient to have the medication that is going to be piggy backed.

5. I did not do hand hygiene before touching the pt and I would have washed my hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before touching the patient at all.
6. Before administering the medication, I would teach the patient about the different side effects and do medication teaching to patient.
7. I did not teach the pt about which medication I was giving, why I was giving the medication, and how often I was going to give the medication. I did not tell the patient the dose of the medication either. I would have done all of that before administering the medication.
8. Before administering the medication, I would ask the patient about her pain level to see if it is still the same as stated in the chart. If the patient stated a 6, I would continue to give the medication.
9. I cleaned the port where the piggy back would be connected and then programmed the medication before connecting the piggy back. If the port got contaminated, I would have cleaned it with a new alcohol pad and connected the piggy back medication, then programmed the med.
10. After taking my gloves off from giving medication, I would have used hand hygiene.
11. I would use three wipes to clean the peri area, and after every side cleaned, I would throw the wipe away.
12. While cleaning the labia with the cleaning wipes before the sterile procedure, one of the sides closed before cleaning the other side. Since this happened, I would have cleaned the side that closed again before continuing to the other side. I realize this part is not a sterile part but if there were feces or other matters on the labias then it would have to be cleaned before the sterile procedure.
13. After opening the sterile kit, the side of the drape touched the bedding, so in this case, I would not use or touch that side of the drape that has been contaminated by the bedding.
14. After taking the gloves out of my pocket, I would have used hand sanitizer again because my hands would be considered dirty since I have touched my uniform which is dirty.
15. Since the sterile glove bag ripped while opening them, I would grab a new pair of sterile gloves. If grabbing a new pair of sterile gloves meant that I walked away from my sterile field, I would then have to grab a brand new kit and start over. I would have to do so because I turned away from my sterile field.
16. While adjusting my gloves, I caught myself adjusting the wrist and I touched my arm breaking sterility. I would have to start the sterile glove part over again because I would need new gloves after touching the non sterile area which was my arm. If I had to walk away from my sterile field, I would have to get a new kit again and start from beginning.
17. When picking up both syringes and putting them both back down, I was over my sterile field w/sterile gloves keeping my syringes sterile. If the syringes would have touched any part outside of the box, sterile field, I would get a new sterile syringe and ask for someone to open the sterile syringe and me grab it while still maintaining my sterility. If no one was available, I would have to break sterility and grab a new kit and start all over.
18. The syringe touched the bedding causing it to not be sterile so I would not touch it until after my sterile procedure is complete (the cath being inside of the pt already because that is the main part that needs to be sterile for pt safety).
19. Before inserting the cath, it looks like I glazed the tip of the cath on my dirty finger. This would mean I broke sterility, and I would have to get a new kit.
20. After finishing my procedure, I would take my gloves off, perform hand hygiene, before touching the pts sheets or anything else.
21. After assessing that the cath was draining, I would assess the urine and document and save the description of the urine and make sure that the whole 700 cc drained into the bag.
22. I did not document and save the GU assessment after I did it. I should have documented and saved the GU assessment.
23. Before leaving the room I would assess my 4 p's, Pain was one of the breaches, and I would ask about pain level before leaving the room.
24. I would make sure the pt was wearing the non slip socks before leaving room.
25. Before finishing my video, I would perform hand hygiene again for one last time before leaving the room.
