Use with caution with patient with bleeding. 3. Independent risk factor for renal failure 4. report discomfort at IV site
Pepcid (famotidine)	H2 Receptor Antagonist	Decrease Gastric Acid	20mg IVP Q12	Yes	D5W, or Normal NSS not given on my shift, push at rate for 2 minutes	Dizziness, HA, Constipation, Vomiting	1. look for blood in MS, or Stool 2. Take prescription with snack 3. report abdominal pain or black tary stools 4. may cause reversible confusion states
Ofirmev (Acetaminophen)	Para-aminophenol derivatives	Analgesic	690mg IVPB Q6	Yes	solution sodium choloride for 15 minutes	Agitation, anxiety, HTN, Oliguria, N/V	1. tell patient to consult prescribed before giving drug to children younger than age 2 2. advise parents the med is short term 3. advise parient with OTC drugs that contain acetaminophen 4. drug can cause acute liver failure

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Morphine	Opioids	Opioids Analgesics	2.25mg IVP Q3 hr PRN (pain Scale 7-10)	Yes	3ml of saline solution at rate of 4-5 minutes	Dizziness, HA, blurred vision, drowsiness	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. make sure it is given slowly over 4- 5 minutes. 2. watch for respiratory depression 3. notify nurse if feeling constipated 4. make sure dosing is actually correct
Pepcid (famotidine)	H2 Receptor Antagonist	Decrease Gastric Acid	20mg/2ml Vial	Yes	D5W, or Normal NSS not given on my shift, push at rate for 2 minutes	Dizziness, HA, Constipation, Vomiting	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. look for blood in MS, or Stool 2. Take prescription with snack 3. report abdominal pain or black tary stools 4. may cause reversible confusion states
Zofran (Ondansetron)	Selective serotonin receptor	Blocks 5- HT3 in the CNS	4mg/2ml IVP Q6 HR (PRN for N/V)	Yes	D5w, or Normal NSS, puth at rate of 4-5 minutes. Not given on my shift	Arrythmias, Hypoxia, dzziness, fatigue	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Look for ecg changes and prolong qt interval 2. Correct electorlyte abnormalities before infusing drug 3. monitor lft results 4. report difficulty breathing post med
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
