enoxaparin (Lovenox)	anti-coagulant	prevent DVT, stroke, or pulmonary embolus	Sub-Q	pre-filled syringes: 30 mg / 0.3 mL 40 mg / 0.4 mL 60 mg / 0.6 mL 80 mg / 0.8 mL	hemorrhage; renal failure; pulmonary edema	1. report any fever, nausea, SOB, 2. bleeding, diarrhea, inj. site pain 3. 4.
insulin aspart (Humalog)	rapid acting insulin	control hyperglycemia	Sub-Q	100 units/mL	hypoglycemia hypokalemia (↓K ⁺ levels) allergic rxn	1. report any SOB or swelling 2. switch up inj. sites 3. report any dizziness, HA, irregular HB 4. eat w/in 15 min after admin
insulin glargine (Lantus, Basaglar, Tujeo)	long acting insulin	control hyperglycemia	Sub-Q	100 units/mL	hypoglycemia hypokalemia allergic rxn	1. report any dizziness, HA, 2. irregular HB, SOB 3. inject daily at the same time & do not mix w/other insulins 4.
Novolog 70/30	intermediate acting insulin	control hyperglycemia	Sub-Q	100 units/mL	hypoglycemia hypokalemia allergic rxn	1. report any dizziness, HA, shakiness, 2. tachycardia, or blurred vision 3. switch up inj. site 4.
Pneumovax 23	VACCINE	protect against disease-causing bacteria	IM - deltoid	0.5 mL	allergic rxn - hives, swelling of face/throat, difficulty breathing, dizziness	1. may experience pain/redness/swelling at inj. site; HA, fever, loss of appetite, drowsiness 2. 3. don't get this if you feel like you have 4. a cold VIS sheet to pt
