Dizziness, Lightheadedness, Swelling of ankles/feet, Hypotension	1. Get up slowly / call for help due to lowering of blood pressure 2. AVOID grapefruit juice due to possible increased level of medicine in blood 3. Report worsening of chest pain immediately 4. Do NOT stop this medication abruptly
Wellbutrin	Norepinephrine-dopamine reuptake inhibitor (NDRIs)	Prevent seasonal affective disorder, depression, suicidal thoughts	XL 150 mg tablet PO daily	Click here to enter text.		Hypertension, Mental/mood changes, tachycardia, seizure, eye pain /swelling/redness	1. Do NOT crush / chew because this can potentiate effects of medication 2. Check blood pressure regularly due to possible rise in blood pressure 3. Report signs of serotonin syndrome such as widened pupils, vision changes, seizures 4. Avoid MAO inhibitors due to a serious drug interaction
Zebeta	Beta-blocker	HTN and heart failure treatment	10 mg tablet PO daily			Hypoglycemia, bradycardia, dizziness,	1. Do NOT stop abruptly, keep taking even if you don't feel sick 2. May mask symptoms of hypglycemia

Lantus	Long-acting insulin glargine	Control of hyperglycemia	24 units SQ daily	<input type="text"/> Click here to enter text.	N/A	Hypoglycemia, Insulin resistance, Insulin allergy, Injection site reactions (pain, redness, irritation)	1. Inject daily at the same time 2. Do NOT mix with other insulins in same syringe 3. Rotate injection sites to avoid lipodystrophy 4. Report s/s of hypoglycemia (headache, sweating, fatigue)
Lovenox	Anticoagulant (low molecular weight heparin)	Prevent DVT, surgical patients, immobile patients, PE, stroke	30 mg SQ daily	<input type="text"/> Click here to enter text.		Bleeding, Fever, Injection site reactions	1. Platelets will be affected, always check before administering 2. Be cautious with surroundings due to easily bleeding/bruising 3. If patient has renal failure, they may need a decreased dose 4. Report blood in urine/stool
Tylenol	Anti-pyretic; non-opioid analgesic	Lower fever & pain levels	500 mg tablet PO q6hr PRN	<input type="text"/> Click here to enter text.		Nausea, stomach pain, decreased liver function	1. Can cause liver damage with excessive use 2. Report difficulty swallowing/breathing

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							3. Administer no more than 4000 mg /day 4. Contraindicated in people taking coumadin
Pravachol	Statin drug	Lower LDL & triglycerides and raise HDL	40 mg (two 20 mg tablets) PO qHs	Click here to enter text.		Mild memory problems, confusion, fever, change in amount of urine	1. Cessation of smoking & lifestyle changes help this medication work better 2. May cause / worsen diabetes 3. Report muscle pain/tenderness/weakness 4. Report dark urine, yellowing of skin/eyes, persistent N/V
Cozaar	Angiotensin receptor blockers	Treats HTN, protects kidneys from damage from diabetes	50 mg tablet PO daily	Click here to enter text.		Dizziness, lightheadednes, fainting, hyperkalemia	1. May raise potassium levels 2. Get up slowly due to hypotension 3. Report changes in amount of urine 4. Avoid drugs that increase potassium like ACE inhibitors
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
