1. Type of Surgery and explain in YOUR words about the surgery.
 - a. Right total knee arthroplasty. This is a procedure done to replace the knee after years of damage, typically from arthritis.
2. What were the medical reasons/cause for the surgery?
 - a. My patient suffered from osteoarthritis, which means the wearing down of joints and bones.
3. From the History and Physical of the patient, what could contribute to any postoperative complications?
 - a. My patient had a history of obesity and coronary artery disease that could lead to a complication post-op.
4. From the complication list TWO nursing interventions.
 - a. It would be most helpful to education this patient on diets, exercising and weight loss. Patient must exercise immediately after a total knee replacement to avoid blood clots. If the patient is obese, it makes it more difficult to move.
 - b. This patient would also benefit from being educated about how stress can worsen coronary artery disease by raising the blood pressure. Stress coping mechanisms should also be involved in this.
