Anxiety, tarry stools, blood in stools, palpitations.	1. Monitor CBC and not changes in lab values indicating possible bleed. 2. Check the main fluid and ensure that it is compatible prior to administering. 3. Inform HCP of itching, rash, or trouble breathing. This can be side effects or signs of an allergic reaction. 4. Take with or without food. Do not double a dose if missed dose.
