

IM2 Asepsis and IV Medication Administration SBAR_2

Situation:

Patient lost footing and fell from a 12-foot ladder while decorating the patio with party lights. Obvious deformity visible right ankle. Surgery is scheduled for noon. Patient reported a pain level of 10 on numeric scale.

Background:

- Drug allergies to ibuprofen, meperidine, penicillin

Assessment:

- VS: BP 162/90, HR 82, R 22, T 100.8° F, SaO₂ 96% on room air
- NPO
- MEWS Score
- Pain is 10 on numeric scale
- Abrasions and contusions bilateral forearms
- A dressing to the right ankle and foot is intact
- Right Subclavian Triple Lumen Central Line – running NS @ 80 mL/hr

Recommendation:

- Perform relevant focused assessment
- Perform any indicated procedure
- Administer medication as indicated
