Stomach pain, itching, tiredness, loss of appetite	1. avoid drinking alcohol to reduce the risk of liver injury 2. avoid other medications containing acetaminophen; excess acetaminophen can cause liver injury 3. Call if you have a skin reaction; acetaminophen can cause a lethal skin reaction 4. report dark urine/clay-colored stool; indicative of liver problems
metoprolol	Beta-blocker	Treats angina and hypertension	50 mg PO	Click here to enter text.	Click here to enter text.	Mild itching or rash, trouble sleeping, confusion, feeling tired	1. may cause dizziness so call before getting up 2. avoid driving until you know how it will affect you 3. avoid alcohol as it can increase certain side effects 4. may cause cold feeling in hands and feet
hydrochloro	Thiazide	Helps prevent	12.5 mg	Click here to enter text.	Click here to enter text.	Vision problems,	1. may cause dizziness so avoid getting up

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thiazide	diuretic	fluid retention and keeps body from absorbing too much salt	PO	Click here to enter text.		jaundice, SOB, dehydration	too quickly to prevent falls 2. avoid becoming overheated or dehydrated during exercise; it can lead to an excess loss of fluid 3. call if you have muscle pain/cramps; caused by electrolyte imbalances 4. avoid tanning beds and excess sunlight without SPF; HCTZ can cause an increased risk of skin cancer
levofloxacin	Fluoroquinolone	Treats bacterial infections	750 mg IVPB	<input type="text"/> Click here to enter text.	750 mg/150 mL	Constipation, headache, trouble sleeping, rash	1. call if you have ringing of the ears or vision problems; may be caused by increased ICP 2. report clay-colored stools/dark urine; indicative of liver problems 3. may cause weakness so call before getting up 4. use caution when ambulating; may cause swelling or tearing of tendons
Ipratropium	Anticholinergic bronchodilators	Treats bronchospasms caused by COPD	2 puffs 17 mcg	<input type="text"/> Click here to enter text.	here to enter text.	Stuffy nose, sore throat, chest tightness, headache	1. may worsen breathing problems 2. report vision problems 3. not a rescue medication for bronchospasm attacks

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							4. must be primed with 2 test sprays before first use or after 3 days of not being used. Close eyes for test sprays; it can cause blurred vision/eye irritation
