lorazepam	Benzodiazepine	For alcohol withdrawal	1-2 mg PO PRN q4 hours for alcohol withdrawal			Sedation, dizziness, unsteadiness, fatigue, confusion, depression, sleep apnea, vertigo	1. Do not use with opioids; can lead to coma or death 2. Monitor patient for signs of respiratory depression and sedation 3. Abuse and misuse of this drug is common; only take the amount prescribed 4. Do not abruptly stop taking this med
haldol	antipsychotic	For psychotic symptoms/agitation	10 mg IM PRN q8 psychotic symptoms /agitation			Akathisia, dystonia, muscle stiffness, sedation, tardive dyskensia	1. Do not use to treat patients with dementia related psychosis 2. Watch for hypotension in IM or IV route 3. Avoid alcohol; avoid getting up too fast 4. Monitor for mental status changes

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diphenhydramine	antihistamine	For psychotic symptoms/agitation	50 mg IM q8 PRN for psychotic symptoms /agitation		N/A	Sedation, confusion, dry mucosa, agranulocytosis, anticholinergic affects	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Caution when driving; can cause CNS depression 2. May potentiate effects of sedatives 3. Caution when using med for elderly 4. Notify physician if symptoms worsen
acetaminophen	Analgesic/antipyretic	Reduce mild to moderate pain and fever	500 mg PO q6 for pain of 1-4 on pain scale			GI hemorrhage, hepatotoxicity, nephrotoxicity	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Do not drink alcohol with this drug. 2. Do not take more than 4000mg q 25 hrs. 3. Take with a full glass of water. 4. Black Box: prevent dosing errors that can result in overdose and death.
olanzapine	Antipsychotic	For agitation	5 mg PO q6 for agitation			Orthostatic hypotension, weight gain, hypercholesterolemia, somnolence	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Do not use to treat patients with dementia related psychosis 2. Patient at risk for severe sedation 3. Monitor patient for suicidal ideation and also for high blood sugar 4. Take med at the same time everyday
ibuprofen	NSAID	Pain of 1-4 on pain scale	400 mg PO q6 for pain of 1-4 on pain scale			Dizziness, epigastric pain, heartburn, constipation, nausea, rash	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Patient at increased risk of cardio issues 2. Report any unusual bleeding 3. Take med with food or milk to avoid GI upset 4. Monitor for any severe adverse reaction

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risperdal	antipsychotic	Schizophrenia, bipolar, irritability from autism	1 mg tablet PO BID	<input type="text"/>		Somnolence, insomnia, agitation, anxiety, headache, parkinsonism	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Do not use to treat patients with dementia related psychosis Monitor if pt has history of low WBC Watch for tardive dyskinesia symptoms Drug may induce orthostatic hypotension
nicotine	Smoking Cessation Aid	Nicotine replacement	21 mg transdermal patch daily	<input type="text"/>		Acne, anorexia, arthralgia, back pain, bronchitis, cough, diarrhea, dizziness, rash	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Stop use if signs of allergic reaction Use caution in patients with hypertension and myocardial infarction Monitor for signs of nicotine overdose Apply patch to clean, dry, hairless skin
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
