GENERAL INFORMATION (Time of assessment, admit diagnosis, general appearance)

time of assessment: 0950

admit diagnosis: Osteoarthritis of left hip

general appearance: clean & well kept

Neurological-sensory (LOC, sensation, strength, coordination, speech, pupil assessment)

LOC: Alert & oriented to person, place, time speech:

Sensation: responds appropriately to sharp ^{stimulation} sensation pupil: 3mm round, equal, strength: HGTW strong, equal bilaterally reactive to light

Psychological/Social (affect, interaction with family, friends, staff)

affect: cheerful

EENT (symmetry, drainage of eyes, ears, nose, throat, mouth, including dentition, nodes, and swallowing)

symmetry: EENT symmetric

drainage: EENT no drainage. swallowing: no difficulty swallowing

dentition: oral mucous pink, no teeth missing

nodes: no palpable nodes

Respiratory (chest configuration, breath sounds, rate, rhythm, depth, pattern)

chest configuration: symmetrical, trachea midline

breath sounds: CTA bilaterally

rate/rhythm: respirations 22, even

depth/pattern: unlabored

Cardiovascular (heart sounds, apical and radial rate, rhythm, radial and pedal pulse, pattern)

heart sounds: S1 & S2 audible ~~all regular~~

apical/radial rate: apical/radial rate 82

rhythm/pattern: regular rate & rhythm

radial/pedal pulse: 2+ bilaterally, no edema noted
