ACETOMET APHEN	Analgesic/ antipyretic	Pain / fever	650 mg q8h PO			Constipation, n/v, HA, insomnia	1. caution in pt with renal / hepatic impairment 2. check pt vital signs every 3 hours, med may cause excessive sedation or respiratory depression 3. skin assesment recommended for pt, this med may cause stevens johnson syndrome 4. pt must read all labels of OTC meds and avoid taking anything containing acetametaphine to avoid toxicity
AMOLODIPI NE	Calcium blocker	Treats HTN, angina , dysrhythmias	10 mg PO daily			Flushed skin, HA, dizziness, peripheral edema , nausea , constipation	1. notify nurse before getting out of bed to avoid falling from s/e 2. perform skin assesment to avoid development of edema 3. Check HR every 6 hours to , med may cause palpitations 4. take missed dose within 12 hours

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ATORVASTATIN	antihyperlipidemic	Lower LDL cholesterol slightly increase HDL	20 mg PO daily			Constipation, diarrhea, heart burn, abdominal cramps	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. LFT prior to beginning med to avoid liver damage</li> <li>2. advise pt to use med in conjunction with low cholesterol diet</li> <li>3. limit grapefruit juice with this med, can potentiate effects</li> <li>4. notify HCP if muscle tenderness occurs, especially if accompanied with fever</li> </ol>
CEFEPIME	cephalosporins	Treatment of infection in skin, bone and joints	2 g IVP q12h		1g/10 ml sterile water 2-4 minutes	Aphasia, HA, rash, bleeding, anemia	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. advise HCP if fever develops, may be sign of superinfection</li> <li>2. med may skew lab results</li> <li>3. Pt teaching: finish all of treatment even if symptoms get better to prevent superinfection</li> <li>4. Report dark colored urine or jaundice, can be sign of hepatotoxicity</li> </ol>
ENOXAPARIN	Anticoagulant	Click here to enter text.	40 mg subq daily			Confusion, CHF, bleeding, severe hypotension, hyperkalemia	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. monitor closely for bleeding, platelet counting below 100,000</li> <li>2. keep protamine sulfate on hand in case of overdose</li> <li>3. check pt serum potassium levels for elevation, med may cause hyperkalemia</li> </ol>

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							4. do not rub site after admin to prevent bruising
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
