Hallucinations 3. Check if patient is pregnant can cause fetal harm 4. Do not give IV or sub Q due to tissue necrosis
lorazepam	Benzodiazepine	Treats anxiety/ sleeping problems	1-2 mg PO PRN q4 hours for alcohol withdrawal	Click here to enter text.		Amnesia, seizures, dizziness, coma, delusions	1. Can cause suicidal ideation 2. Check RR due to respiratory depression 3. Check liver enzymes due to elevation 4. Call nurse before getting up due to dizziness
haldol	antipsychotic	Treats Schizophrenia. Improves thinking, mood, and behavior	10 mg IM PRN q8 for psychotic symptoms /agitation	Click here to enter text.		Seizures, confusion, anxiety, depression	1. Call nurse before getting up due to dizziness 2. Can cause constipation teach pt about staying hydrated 3. Bronchospasm can occur

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							4. Can cause menstrual irregularities
diphenhydramine	antihistamine	Used for allergies or for sedating	50 mg IM q8 PRN for psychotic symptoms /agitation	 Yes	N/a	Confusion, dizziness, blurred vision, hemolytic anemia	1. Advise patient to take drug with food to minimize GI distress 2. Instruct to wear sunscreen to prevent any photosensitivity reactions 3. Call nurse before getting up due to dizziness 4. Avoid taking this with other OTC drugs that have diphenhydramine to prevent additive effects
acetaminophen	Antipyretic, non-opioid analgesic	Treats fever and pain	500 mg PO q6 for pain of 1-4 on pain scale	 Click here to enter text.		Hypokalemia, Atelectasis, jaundice, hypoglycemic coma	1. Check BP due to hypotension 2. Can cause hepatotoxicity 3. Check RR and hear lungs due to pulmonary edema or dyspnea 4. Check liver function tests including AST, ALT, bilirubin, and creatine levels
olanzapine	Antipsychotic	Treats s/s of Schizophrenia	5 mg PO q6 for agitation	 Click here to enter text.		Abnormal gait, altered thermoregulation, amnesia, hypertonia	1. Can cause suicidal ideation 2. Check BP due to hypotension 3. Should not be used for elderly patients with dementia-related psychosis due to increased risk of death 4. Used in caution in patients with hepatic

ibuprofen	Analgesic	Relieves pain	400 mg PO q6 for pain of 1-4 on pain scale	Click here to enter text.		Fluid retention, constipation, heartburn, aplastic anemia	1. Can increase MI and strokes 2. Caution in asthma, CHF, and hypertension 3. Call for help if feeling dizzy 4. Advise patient to take drug with food or after meals to reduce GI distress
risperdal	antipsychotic	Treats Schizophrenia	1 mg tablet PO BID	Click here to enter text.		Seizures, hypothermia, anxiety, depression, confusion, agitation	1. Can cause diabetic ketoacidosis 2. Check glucose due to hypoglycemia 3. Use cautiously in patients with a history of seizures 4. Monitor for orthostatic hypotension
nicotine	Nicotinic Agonist	Stops smoking	21 mg transdermal patch daily	Click here to enter text.		Dizziness, dream disturbances, amnesia	1. Call nurse before getting up due to dizziness 2. Caution in patients with hyperthyroidism 3. Caution with patients with active peptic ulcers 4. Teach pt. they must stop smoking as soon as tx. Starts to avoid toxicity
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
