Type of Action taken: Suspend/Probate

Blasini failed to notify the doctor about an ongoing situation of FHR tracing that was decelerating into the eighties(80) and nineties(90) that showed an indeterminate baseline. It continued to the point with prolonged deceleration of stress to the fetus than early decelerations likely to injure the unborn baby. Blasini documented that the FHR baseline was one hundred fifteen (115) beats per minute and that there were early and variable decelerations of the FHR. She failed twice to assess the maternal heart rate and blood pressure of the aforementioned patient during her shift as well. Maternal vital signs are important to assess because the fetus is dependent on adequate maternal blood pressure to maintain a normal FHR.

I personally working in Labor n Delivery, I would have got a second set of eyes to look at the strip and reevaluated the findings by repositioning the patient first and for most. The second thing I would have done was check the blood pressures of the mother to see if I needed to give her some medications and fluids to help the FHR and then notify the doctor. It's always good to get someone else's input and take it as a learning experience before something atrophic happens, like in this situation.

As a prudent nurse I would intervene and try to help the nurse in helping her reevaluate the patients strip and suggest giving her fluids and reposition. After this was done, I would call the doctor and let them know of the situation and let them know of the actions taken and reevaluate in an hour.
