Comments:

- I did not wash my hands after leaving the med room when I should have. I will wash my hands when leaving the med room.
- I did not let the patient know the duration of the procedure. I should have verbalized that the entire procedure would take about 30 minutes.
- I did not let the patient know the dosage of the medication when I should have. I briefly mentioned the route of medication administration but I was not thorough in explaining the procedure. In the future I will let the patient know the medication dosage and procedure when educating them about the medication.
- When performing the injection in the ventrogluteal muscle, I did not hold the syringe in place with my other hand before aspirating. In the future I will secure the syringe with my other hand before aspirating.

-I did not mention in the video that I would dispose of the empty vial of morphine in the sharp's container along with the needle and syringe.

-I mentioned in the video that I broke sterility when the CVAD dressing change kit touched the bed. In the future I will try to keep the table at a safe distance to prevent that from happening again. If the sterile field is contaminated, I will have to restart the procedure with a new CVAD dressing change kit.

-I did not verbalize that I would document assessment findings or procedures in my video. I would document these on the computer in the patient's room.

-I did not verbalize that I would check on the patient in about 15-20 minutes regarding their reaction to the morphine. I would let the patient know the time I will come back to check on their vitals and overall status.
