Comments: Medication administration- Must verbalize the 7 rights to the patient the correct patient, medication, the time, the route, the reason, must always assess sight for medication administration visually and by palpation to make sure it is a suitable location.

Sterile procedure- If a sterile hand to hand pass is not performed you should change out to new sterile gloves from possible contamination.

Hand hygiene- Hand hygiene must be performed before and after any change of gloves, and upon entering a patient's room

Teach Patient: Medication, Inform the patient about the medication and possible adverse reactions before administration, Procedure teach patient about the dressing and the importance of keeping it sterile not getting wet and if any changes to the site happen to notify the nurse.

Don and change gloves- when sterility is in question change gloves immediately  
Asepsis- maintain a sterile field and change to a new pair of sterile gloves if procedure is not exact and the contamination is in question.
