- The RN should have called 911 herself instead of delaying treatment

- If I was the first to discover the patient or if I was the case manager in this instance I would have not delegated an assessment to a LVN because that is beyond their scope of practice. Upon assessing the patient, I would have had the patient taken to the ER immediately after the findings of the BP 130/110 and the irregular breathing. I would have assessed lung sounds and checked for Temp, and O2 sats as the patient was sweating. I would have not waited to get an appointment as this was an urgent matter.
